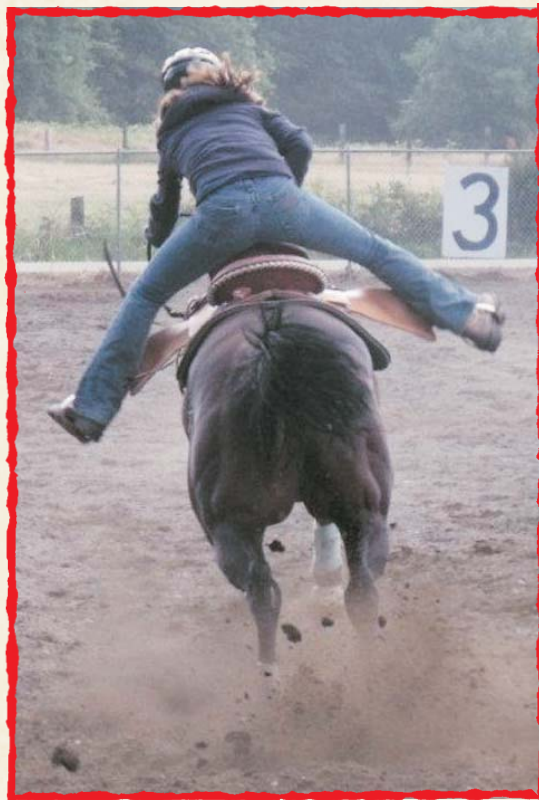
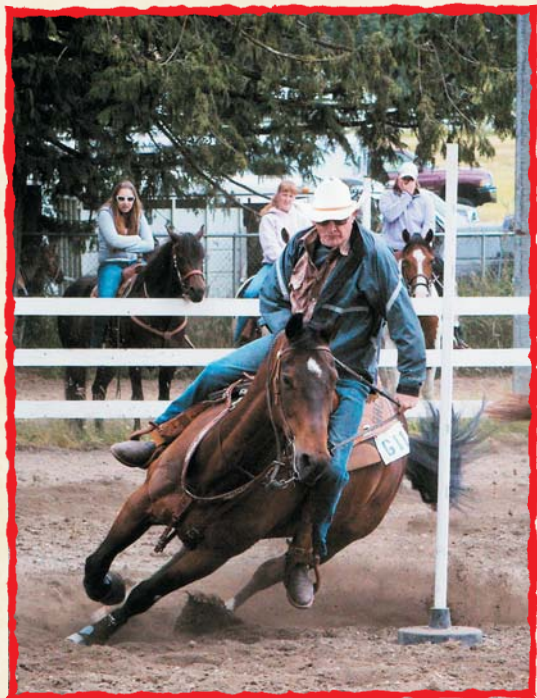

Patterned Horse Racing

Snohomish County Western Games Association was formed in 1973 by a small group of local families who wanted patterned horse racing (also known as gaming or playdays) competition during the winter months. Because this is a family organization, the division of competition was divided by age of rider instead of ability of horse. This enables one horse to be used by more than one family member or rider. SCWGA continued to grow over the years and has expanded to include several counties in Western Washington. Since its founding, SCWGA has maintained its goals of promoting patterned horse racing and preserving friendly, family competition by providing a place for riders of all ages and levels of ability to perform.

2010-2011 Membership & Show Information

The SCWGA season begins with the Evergreen State Fair on Labor Day weekend each year. The season continues with shows once per month, except October and February, and is brought to a close with a two-day show in March. SCWGA wraps up its season with an annual awards banquet where all members and their families are invited to celebrate with one another.

All riders who attend the Evergreen State Fair are required to be members of Snohomish County Western Games. However, membership is not required at our other shows.

Riders must be an active member in good standing of SCWGA and ride at a minimum of three shows per season in order to qualify for year-end awards. Riders must also work the specified minimum at each show they attend in order to qualify for year-end awards.
