GUIDELINES

- **OPEN to MEMBERS ONLY LIMITED 160 riders**
- Camping must be prepaid, see form below
- Helmets are recommended
- WAIVER forms required to ride
- Camping passes can be picked up Friday at check-in
- Pay outs will be available at the next show
- All payments must be mailed in with entry form and by check!
- PLEASE be aware of the COVID-19 pandemic guidelines including but not limited to staying 6 feet apart and wearing a mask when necessary
- NO SPECTATORS – only parents of youth riders and members that have signed up to ride
- Warm up precautions will be in place and explained at the riders meeting Saturday morning
- Please respect these new rules due to COVID-19

- Riders under 18 years old must have a guardian present at all times
- Contestants must know and follow SCWGA rules
- Entries received after the due date will only be accepted on space availability.
- Entries will not be accepted at the show.
- No cash refunds * Refunds, if granted by the board, will be in the form of a certificate to be used at a future show.
- Hand sanitizing and mask stations will be provided, please bring a mask as well!
- Fairgrounds faculty will not be present other than to work the ground in the arenas, the SCWGA board is stepping up and filling that spot so please be courteous to each board member!
- The office and crows nest will only be open to board members or workers only!
- **RIDERS MEETING SATURDAY MORNING 8:30 AM ALL RIDERS MUST BE PRESENT OUTSIDE OF THE BARN AND ARENAS. THE ANNOUNCING WILL BE OVER THE LOUD SPEAKER.**

HERDSMANSHIP

- Stalls must be clean by 9:30am daily and picked regularly if needed. IF YOUR STALL IS NOT KEPT CLEAN YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE
- Stalls must have a posted SCWGA stall card that is completely filled out
- No tack stalls, unless you purchase one
- Barns will be inspected by the board members.
- Shavings will not be provided ~ riders must bring their own shavings, a minimum of 1 bag per stall: regular flake pine/cedar shavings are required for each stall.
- **Stalls must be completely stripped into the aisle way at the end Sunday and checked by the board member or stall check out member, if your stall is not cleaned you will not be invited back to SCWGA and your membership will be revoked for the rest of the year.**
- If you have to leave before Sunday evening you must notify Julie Guthrie or Letisha Cook, and you will need to strip your stall to the bunkers.
- You must bring your own stall cleaning utensils to be able to strip your stall. (ie: brooms, shovel, wheel barrow, pitch fork)

PART "A" – WAIVER & RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to enter any Snohomish County Property or being permitted to complete, officiate, observe, work for or for any purpose participate in any way in the event or activity, EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for themselves, or their personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin, acknowledges, agrees and represents that they have, or will immediately upon entering any of such County areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect such County areas and all portions thereof which they enter and which they come in contact, and they do further warrant that their entry upon such County area or areas and their participation, if any in the event or activity constitutes an acknowledgment that they have inspected such County area and that if, at any time, they are in or about these areas and they feel anything to be unsafe they will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the unsafe area(s):

I . HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES, AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE Snohomish county and any of its elected or appointed officials, officers, employees and agents all for the purposes herein referred to as County", from all liability to the undersigned, their personal representatives, assigned heirs or next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefor on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of County or otherwise while the undersigned is in or upon or crossing the area, and/or competing, officiating in, observing, working for, or for any purpose participating in the event.

- HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the county from any city liability damage, or cost it may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the area or in any way competing, officiating, observing, or working or any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the County or otherwise.
- HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of county or to otherwise while in or upon the area and/or in preparation for during or after competing, officiating, observing, or working for or for any purpose participating in the event.
- EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities at the event and in the areas are dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death. EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver and indemnify agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State in which the event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, not citifying continue in full legal force and effect.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements or inducement apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

This waiver, release and indemnification agreement specifically embraces each and every event or activity sanctioned, authorized or promoted by Snohomish County Evergreen State Fairgrounds during the entire season and applies to each and every event or activity herein above mentioned, and has the same effect as if executed after each and every event or activity in which the undersigned participants so that the parties herein intended to be released and indemnified shall be fully and effectively released and indemnified as to each and every event or activity hereinabove described.

Youth through all Senior classes will be required to work at any show they ride at, to be eligible for year end points. Little Trainer riders are not required to work. Other family members can work for riders' worker points. Some jobs do require training prior to being allowed to work in the position, such as: announcers, timers, judges, and calculations. Workers sign-up schedules will be available at each show or contact board members listed on the website or in the newsletter. To fulfill worker/rider points you must ride the majority of the shows and receive six (6) worker credits per show/day to receive year end awards.

Members will receive club updates via Snohomish County Western Games Association on Facebook or website. Members acknowledge that all mailing and contact information will be provided to all SCWGA members by distribution of a membership list. SCWGA is not responsible for any purpose in which members may use that contact information, including mass mailings or solicitations. Check payable to SCWGA. RV-5 has 12 full hookup spaces (sewer, water, electric) and is inside the Equestrian Park. These RV sections are closed to general public. SCWGA will be taking money for camping reservations to give to the fairgrounds at the end of the weekend.

Please respect all camp area lines and do not park in the roadways or block other camp sites. Please move extra vehicles to parking spots in the parking lots. In addition please respect a 10:00 PM curfew (turn down loud music, dim lights, etc.) while in camping area.
